Things are well on their way for our show! Kids are working hard (and seem very excited), choreography is coming along, costumes are being ordered and trouble-shot. Volunteer sheets are still circling. Thank you to everyone who has already signed up to help. If you think you can help, and haven't yet put down your name, it's not too late! We will especially be looking at any holes for Class Coordinator, who play an integral roll at show time. If you have questions about specific volunteer positions please don't hesitate to ask me about them.

There was a lot of information given out at the Parent Meetings last month. Here is a re-cap on some of the important details.

All cast rehearsals are on November 22 and December 6, and start at 1:00 for Act I and 3:30 for Act II. Act I includes Party Scene (parents, party girls and boys, dolls, baby dolls), Mouse Scene (Soldiers and Mice), and Snow Scene (Snow Flakes and Snow Balls). Act II includes Angels,

Spanish, Chinese, Hungarian, Arabian, Russian, Candy Canes, Flowers, Bon Bons, and Gum Drops.

All dancers should be at both all-cast rehearsals except Creative Movement and Pre-Ballet I. Creative Movement and Pre-Ballet I: If you perform the 13 you come to All-cast on November 22; if you perform the 14 you should plan to come December 6.

Costume information will be posted by the middle of the month. It will be on the bulletin board downstairs. I try to keep costumes and costs practical and reasonable. Some costumes are only a \$5 cleaning fee. It adds up quickly if


you need both shoes and leos. The average cost is about \$30. Costume fees are due by December 6.

Saturday, December 13 (and November 22 rehearsal): Monday 5:15 Creative Movement, Thursday 2:45 Creative Movement, Monday 5:45 Pre-Ballet I, Saturday 10:15 Pre-Ballet I, Tuesday 4:00 Pre-Ballet II, Thursday 5:45 Pre-Ballet II.



Performance Weekend

Performance weekend will be packed - probably with both excitement and confusion, especially for newer ABA families. I do my best to lay things out as clear as possible in advance, but every year presents something new and exciting. I ask for your

patience as we navigate this weekend with around 250 performers! I promise, in the end the organized chaos does lead to a successful show.



The afternoon/evening of December 12 is spacing rehearsal. Spacing is for Pre-Ballet II and up, all jazz, and Boys II. Call times are as follows:

3:45: Ballet IV, V, and Jazz III, and Clara

5:00: Ballet II, Jazz I & II, Boys II

6:00: Ballet II, Pre-Ballet III, and Party Parents

Spacing rehearsal is not done in costume. Student should wear their regular classroom attire including leos, tights, shoes, and hair should be secured in buns. Similarly, no stage make-up is

necessary for allcast rehearsal.

Dress rehearsal, starting at 10:00 on December 13, is a different matter. Dancers should be prepared as if they were doing the

performance. Know that 10:00 is the start time, and you should give yourself ample time to find your class and costumes, change, and get to the auditorium by 10:00. My recommendation is to be there at least 30 minutes early, maybe even a little more.

We should be done with the first run of dress rehearsal by 1:00, when the Creative Movement and Pre-Ballet I students will be dismissed. All other dancers will be dismissed as they finish their last dance of the 2nd run-through. I hope to be done with both runthroughs by 3pm, giving everyone sufficient time for a dinner break. Dancers need to be back to the theatre by 6pm for the Saturday
