Call times are as follows: Ballet IV & Ballet V – 3:30pm Boys II, Contemporary II, & Contemporary III – 4:30pm Ballet I, Ballet II, Ballet III, and Jazz I – 4:45 Pre-Ballet II – 6:00pm. For spacing dancers do not wear costumes, and do not need make up. Please just come in your usual class attire, with hair in a bun.

The Dress Rehearsals will take place on Saturday, December 12th, beginning at 10:00am, at the Elsinore Theatre. Unlike spacing, dancers should be in full costume and full make up, just like they will be for the show. We will be starting at 10:00, so we suggest you arrive at least 30 minutes early. We will run two dress rehearsals. The first one should finish by 1:00pm at which time the Creative movement and Pre-Ballet I students will be dismissed. All other dancers will be dismissed as they finish the second run. We hope to finish the second run by 3:00pm, so that everyone gets a good break. Call times for the shows are 6:00pm on Saturday, and 1:30pm on Sunday.
