Things to Remember Some classes that are easy to forget, but are great to take

- 1. FREE Boys class. There are two levels. Both meet Saturday morning at 11:30. Boys 1 is mostly for boys 5-8. Boys II is for boys 8+. This is a great chance to make friends and work on some things that are more specific to the male dancer. If you have a son, or know of a boy who might be interested, please come check it out!
- 2. Jazz. Jazz is very supplemental to ballet, and is a lot of fun! It is a great opportunity to work on strength, flexibility, and is a change of pace from the regular ballet classes.
- 3. Community Ballet. You watch your child dance in class week after week... why don't you come in and give it a try? Community Ballet is more laid back, doesn't require performances, is great exercise, and a lot of fun!

Dress Code, Back to School Sale, and Notes on Ballet Etiquette

A quick reminder about dress code. Girls should wear a solid colored leotard, pink tights, and pink shoes. If your child has black tights or shoes from past shows it is acceptable

to wear them to class. Ballet I-IV: Now skirts! Ballet III and up can wear fitted black shorts, though it is recommended



that these are not worn during every class as students need to be comfortable in plan leos and tights also. Ballet I and up: Hair must be worn in a bun. This is both traditional and functional, and is a very important part of your child's training. If you need to find another parent to help you make this happen please do.

Tuesdays from 4:45-5:45 and Saturday from 10:15-11:45, or by appointment outside of class time. There will be a store sale this Saturday, the 6th, from 2:30-4:30. Come in then, say hello, and get your dance clothes at a good price!
