Dress Code and Back to Dance Sale

With the start of the new year, we like to write a little about the dress code for new students, and as a refresher for returning students. Girls should wear a solid colored leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet slippers. If you have black tights or shoes from past performances, it is acceptable to wear these to class. Ballet I-III are not allowed to wear skirts. They can wear tight fitting black shorts sometimes, but need to be comfortable in just a leotard and tights.

Girls Ballet I and up need to have hair pulled back in a proper ballet bun. This is both traditional and functional. If you need help with this, it's alright to ask another parent to help you!

We know many of you will come to the studio and find your dance attire is no longer fitting, or has been misplaced over the summer! Don't forget we have a small store that provides basic attire for your dance classes including shoes, tights and leos. Normal hours are Tuesday from 4:30-5:30 and Saturday from 10:15-11:45. Next week we will have some additional back-to-school hours as follows: Monday and Wednesday from 5:30-6:30; Tuesday and Thursday from 4:30-5:30; Saturday 10:15-11:45. This Saturday, the 10th, through next Saturday, the 17th, we will have our "Back to School Sale". We hope to see you there!

We'd also like to say a few words about ballet etiquette. These niceties are universal in the ballet world, and are good for dancers of all ages to know and practice. It is important for your dancer to be at class on time, in proper attire. Hands should be raised to ask or answer questions, and talking should be kept to an absolute minimum in class. Your dancer should always thank the teacher at the end of class. Please keep absences to a minimum, and be sure to let your teacher know when you have to miss. Dancers should never lean on walls or the barre. Please go over these rules with your dancer!
